IMPLEMENTATION OF FULL HOME-BASED LEARNING (8 April – 4 May 2020)

- 1. In line with the Multi-Ministry Taskforce's latest efforts to further enhance safe distancing measures, schools will step up their safe distancing measures. From 8 April 2020, all MOE schools will shift to full Home-Based Learning (HBL) till 4 May 2020.
- 2. Our school, like all other secondary schools, will be shifting to full HBL from 8 April 2020 to 4 May 2020. During the period of full HBL, our school will provide instructions and support for your child to access a range of both online and hardcopy HBL resources so that learning can continue.
- 3. During HBL, each class will follow their respective class timetable for the day and start each day with Form Teacher Time (FTT) where their Form Teachers will take attendance and check in on the students' well-being. The HBL lesson for each subject may be a mix of elearning, reading textbooks / notes, completing workbooks / worksheets / assignments. Completed assignments may need to be submitted by students via different modes (e.g., via SLS, email etc) to respective subject teachers.
- 4. Student and parents would be able to access two HBL related documents (customised according to class) on the school website (https://jurongwestsec.moe.edu.sg/highlights/hbl-guide) as follows:

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- 5. Your child/ward will be briefed by his/her Form Teacher during FTT on 7 April 2020 and will be provided with the necessary instructions for full HBL as well as advised to take HBL as seriously as they would take lessons in school. You may wish to support your child by providing a conducive environment at home through:
 - Working out a daily schedule/routine with your child and guiding your child in setting goals and scheduling tasks. For further tips on guiding your child in setting goals, refer to the Resilience Boosters at https://go.gov.sg/selresforparents.
 - Establishing an agreement with your child on managing screen time. We will assign
 about 2 hours of screen time on the computer each HBL Day. For further tips and

 - Encouraging your child to maintain an optimistic and positive outlook while accepting the changes and emotions that he/she has had to face as part of going through HBL.
- 6. If your child needs learning or emotional support, he/she can approach any one of his/her teachers and other school personnel such as our allied educators and school counsellors, who will continue to work from home or from school. Your child's form teachers as well as subject teachers will also be in regular contact with you and your child.
- 7. The school-based Mid-Year Examination and Common Test will be cancelled. However, national examinations, including the mid-year GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Language Examinations in June, Year-End school-based Examinations and Year-End GCE O-Level Examinations will proceed as planned and with the necessary precautionary measures in place.
- 8. Our teachers will continue to monitor the progress of your child through assignments and unweighted assessments which would be marked and returned to students. These may be done online via SLS or emails. Subject teachers would also conduct online remediation as well as consultation.

Details of the remediation and consultation sessions for identified students who will be informed by respective subject teachers are as follows:

Secondary 4 & 5	Monday – Friday from 2:25pm onwards To follow the structured remedial schedule sent out previously



To continue to keep students engaged in CCA experiences which they are very passionate about as well as connected to their CCA mates, the school has scheduled short online CCA sessions for Secondary 1 – 3 students as follows:

- 10. Please ensure that your child stays at home during HBL and continues to observe good hygiene practices such as washing their hands frequently with soap. If he/she feels unwell, please seek medical attention promptly and inform his/her form teacher if he/she displays any fever or flu-like symptoms.
- 11. We plan to resume classes on 5 May 2020. MOE will continue to closely monitor the COVID-19 situation to assess if HBL needs to be extended. We urge you to rely on official sources of information and not to circulate any unconfirmed information.
